Success Criteria that will be achieved:

Session 1

Learn how all behavior is impacted by performance and skill strengths/deficits. Explore the rationale for determining which is at play and its importance within intervention planning.

Session 2

Find solutions to identify if individual student challenging behavior is the result of skill deficits, performance deficits, or a combination of both. Harness actionable steps to take to address performance deficits.

Session 3

Leverage an evidence-based teaching methodology - "teaching interactions", to explicitly teach missing skills. Reimagine the rationale behind using teaching interactions, as well as, the core steps to unlock & empower learning in your classroom. Take home downloadable resources.
