Participants will gain the knowledge to develop a school or classroom discipline plan based on the principles of Restorative Practices, which meet the requirements of the Illinois Discipline Legislation (September, 2016).

Debbie Poffinbarger: PLC Implementation: During this workshop, the presenter will share the process of a clear path to continuous improvement.
