If doing more in our schools and classrooms was the answer to better meeting the needs of every child, we'd have met every goal and closed every gap by now. We don't need more activity. We need more clarity.

Clarity emerges when we see less with greater focus. With focus, we have time to explore, appreciate, and find meaning. We notice. The enemy of focus is clutter. Clutter is what happens when we are required to see more with less focus. With clutter, there is never enough time. There is always more. And as quickly as it came into our field of vision, it disappears before we'd even noticed it was there.

The first step on the path to clarity is eliminating clutter. Specifically, the clutter we put in front of kids across the 16,380 instructional periods they experience in a typical k-12 education system. Clutter is anything that inhibits our ability to help students prioritize their strategic efforts to learn. Clarity begins to emerge when we have the discipline to strive for clarity in three areas central to our shared purpose.
