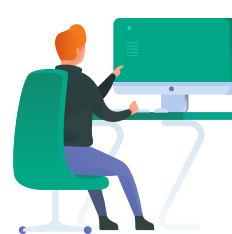


Register for one module or all three

Module 1 - Learn the Tech
