- Explore how to use a simple two-step differentiation process to quickly and easily reach more students as well as to plan full lessons

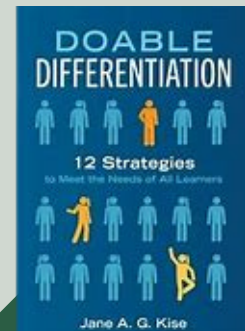
